Hazard Check

Before Session

Number of rollers

Check entire area starts "clear"

Check sufficient staff to run the session

Check all wires taped down

Check all lighting equipment safely installed

Check legs on stands correctly spaced

Check bollards correctly spaced

Check fire doors clear

Check all signs displayed

Wet weather - check no water slip hazards (fire doors open?)

Identify newcomers and give advice on falling

Check protective gear correctly worn

Identify safe area for spectators

During Session - Remain vigilant at all times

Ensure all skate clockwise in sensible manner

Check vulnerable people are wearing safety gear

Marshalls to give advice to newcomers

Check no equipment dislodged

Check no wires dislodged

Check lighting stands not dislodged

After Session Ends

Number of rollers

Switch off all equipment at source and leave to cool

Do not dismantle any equipment until trained.

Stow equipment safely and neatly

Do not carry excessive weight - use dilly truck

Check entire area clear at end

IF UNSURE - ASK

Other hazard identified / observations / suggestions for next time

A **hazard** is something that can cause harm. The **risk** is the probability (High Medium Low) it might occur

In making the assessment consider the seriousness of the potential outcome
